The exact time of your child's procedure is not confirmed at this time. A representative from William Beaumont hospital-Royal Oak will contact you with the specific time, place, and any preparation for eating on _____ after 2:00 pm. The hospital schedules the surgery times in age order with the youngest going first. If you have not received a telephone call by 6:00 pm, you may inquire at (248) 551-1500.

PRE-SURGICAL TESTING

If you are having anesthesia, you will need pre-surgical testing. This includes an evaluation by the anesthesiologist, blood work, as well as any additional testing that may be necessary to clear your child for anesthesia.

_____ You will receive your advance testing on the same day of admission. You must follow through if your physician has instructed you to get surgical clearance from any other doctor that is treating your child.

_____ You will receive a telephone call from Advanced Testing for an appointment prior to your surgery date. Advanced Testing is located in the Medical Office Building, 7th Floor, Suite 732. You should check in approximately 15 minutes earlier than your scheduled appointment. You may telephone and schedule an appointment at (248) 423-3100.

*****If your child has any heart or other medical conditions, please let us know as he/she may require additional antibiotics. A letter of surgical clearance may be needed from the physician treating your child for certain conditions.

*****If your insurance has a co-pay or you have a deductible, payment is required one week prior to surgery or surgery will be cancelled.
